Holders of the National Certificate Level 3 in Art & Design can demonstrate basic operational knowledge, skills, and attributes of Art & Design in the areas or domains of: fine and digital arts and crafts, textiles and project management.

6. Qualification pathways:

Upon successful completion of the National Certificate Level 3 in Art and Design, learners can choose to enrol for the Level 3 Pearson BTEC Extended Diploma in Art and Design. The awarding body is also coming up with a new qualification - National Certificate Level 4 in Art & Design.
