4.1 Entry Information

Candidates who are between 18 and 35 years of age and who:

(i) possess a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including one Science subject obtained on one certificate

or

(ii) passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including one Science subject obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.
