6. Purpose of Qualification:

The National Certificate Level 5 in Construction Supervision is designed to provide people credited with the qualification the skills and knowledge required by a capable construction supervisor. The qualification is aimed at people already working as a construction supervisor or alternatively those wishing to move into the role.

The qualification comprises compulsory supervisory and technical standards designed to assess a broad range of knowledge and skills. Supervisory skills include on-site administration and supervision, preparation of construction programmes, time management, knowledge and implementation of site safety plans, communication skills as related to building sites, knowledge of drawings and specifications, and preparation of order lists. Technical skills include knowledge of excavations, construction methods, weatherproofing, exterior cladding, subcontractor supervision, and principles of building design.
